

Information for parents on the processing of personal data and declaration of consent

The use of online learning platforms has in the meantime become a widespread form of modern teaching. At our school, the following password-protected web applications from the Westermann Group can be used by your child with your consent:

- Alfons (to improve skills in German, Mathematics and English)
- Antolin (to improve reading skills)
- BiBox (allows the teacher to provide children with digital material to accompany their lessons)
- Grundschule Interaktiv (for interactive exercises)
- Online Diagnose Grundschule (for tailor-made support based on an individual diagnosis of key skills)
- Zahlenzorro (to improve mathematical skills)

To enable teaching staff to follow the children's learning progress, the children log into these web applications using their own individual access data, which is identical for all Westermann Group applications. For this purpose, the following data is collected:

- First name and surname of the child, or nickname
- The user name and password (account) are created by the provider
- Gender (in order to address the child correctly)
- Name of school and description of class
- Information on whether the child's answers were correct, the time when the questions were answered and how long they took to answer
- Messages sent via the system

The legal basis for processing the data is Art. 6 para. 1 point a) of the GDPR. Apart from the children, only the teaching staff can gain access to the personal data that has been collected. The personal data is only used within the context of the web application and cannot be viewed by any unauthorised persons. Furthermore, this personal data is only stored for as long as it is required for the exercises and for the development of the child's skills.

The Westermann Group do not have access to the data apart from in the web application. The Westermann Group will not collect or process any personal data for any other purpose (e.g. advertising).

There will be no transfer of data to any third parties.

The Westermann Group has taken extensive technical and organisational measures to protect the data from being accessed by third parties and from the loss of data.

You also have the following rights in accordance with the statutory regulations:

- The right to information (Art. 15 of the GDPR),
- The right to have your data deleted (Art. 17 of the GDPR),
- The right to have your data corrected (Art. 16 of the GDPR),
- The right to data portability (Art. 20 of the GDPR),
- The right to have the processing of your data restricted (Art. 18 of the GDPR),
- The right to object to the processing of your data (Art. 21 of the GDPR).

If you wish to assert any of these rights, please contact the school management team via email (_____@_____) or via post to _____. You also have the right to make a complaint to the data protection supervisory authorities about the processing of your personal data.
